Congratulations to the varsity boys track team. They took #1 in the MITCA division 4 state championship, scoring 1,308 points, 86 1/2 points ahead of the runner-ups.

New MI School Rating

The state of Michigan has a new school index rating system, which has been used for the first time by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE). The system provides a rating for nearly all Michigan public schools based upon performance in up to six categories. The weight of each category is different.

1. Student growth: 34%
2. Student proficiency: 29%
3. School quality/student success: 14% (which is a category that can include everything from chronic absenteeism to student access to arts and physical education)
4. Graduation rate: 10%
5. English learner progress: 10%
6. Assessment participation: 3%

MDE is using the ratings to determine which schools need additional oversight and support to improve student performance. With this new system the median rating for Michigan schools was 71.89.

Addison High School was rated with an 82.64 in 5 of the 6 categories: student growth 78.04, student proficiency 82.76, school quality/student success 83.49, graduation rate 93.42, and assessment participation 99.58.

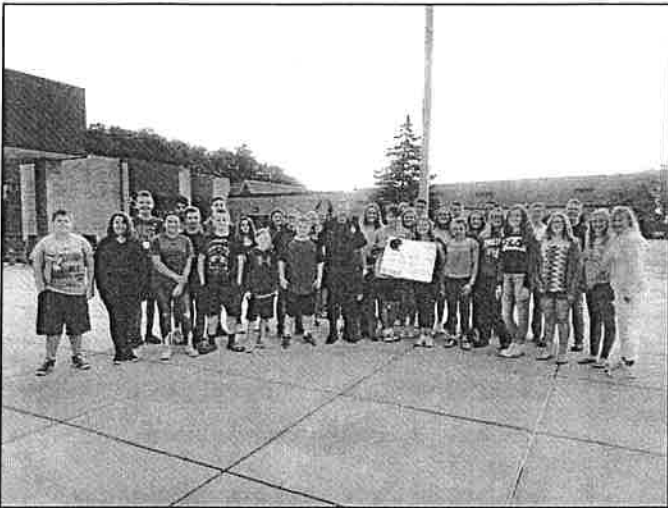

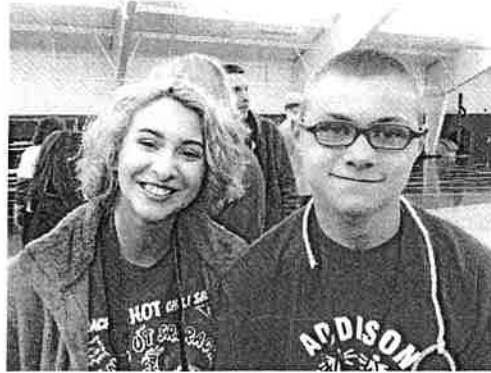
