Dear Student, Parent/Guardian, Staff Member:

As part of Addison Community School District's pest management program, we will be applying fertilizer containing herbicides to control broadleaf weeds on our school grounds.

A controlled fertilizer and herbicide application will be applied by a technician from *Green Blade One*, who is State licensed and trained in the use of fertilizers and herbicides. All grounds will be posted after the application. The treatment is described below:

Date of Application: Saturday, May 18 & Sunday, May 19, 2019

Area to be Treated - entire campus

Description of Treatment:

We will use a mechanical spray system to deliver a 1 gallon dilution/1,000 sq. ft.. The dilution will consist of: 1.5 oz. of Triad Select Herbicide.

Selective Broadleaf Weed Control in Turf grasses Including Use on Golf Courses and Sod Farms To Control Clover, Dandelion, Henbit, Plantains, Wild Onion, and Many Other Broadleaf Weeds. Also for Highways, Rights-of-Way, and Other Similar Non-Crop Areas as Listed on This Label.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

*Dimethylamine Salt of 2,4-D 30.89%
 **Dimethylamine Salt of MCPA 8.23%
 ***Dimethylamine Salt of Dicamba 2.77%

OTHER INGREDIENTS: 58.11%

Contains:

*2.38 lbs. 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid per gallon or 25.65%.
 **0.63 lb. 2-methyl-4-chlorophenoxyacetic acid per gallon or 6.72%.
 ***0.22 lb. 3,6-dichloro-o-anisic acid per gallon or 2.30%.

We will use a mechanical spray system to deliver a 1 gallon dilution/1,000 sq. ft.. The dilution will consist of: 1.5 oz. of Credit 41 Extra Non-Selective Herbicide, 1.1 oz. Primera Triplet SF Selective Herbicide per gallon of dilution. EPA numbers are on the attached labels.
