- Age cut-off: Dec. 31 (softball); Apr 30 (baseball).
- Registration form will **NOT** be accepted **WITHOUT** payment!!
- Registration form and money must be submitted in a sealed envelope.
- Refunds will **NOT** be offered once uniforms are ordered.
- Make checks payable to 'Addison Summer Ball League'. If you do not have exact change, ASB will refund the difference before games begin. Do **NOT** pay in change.
- \$20.00 fee for returned checks due to non-sufficient funds
- 12U/14U Baseball - Due to numbers (players or coaches), there may be a need to have try-outs. A refund will be provided if player does not make team.

***If your player starts playing ball at 4 y/o, they will NOT be allowed to move to the next age group until they meet the age requirement. Player MUST turn 4 by this past December 31 .**

SPORT PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

We, the Addison Summer Ball have implemented the following Sport Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read and understand this form prior to their children participating in our Program.

Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any practice or game will be given a warning about their conduct. If improper conduct continues, the parent will be suspended from all practices and games. A suspension will apply to all children the parent(s)/guardian(s) have playing.

- I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game and practice.
- I (and my guests) will NOT engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or spectator such as taunting, using profane language or gestures, or arguing calls.
- I will require that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field and will take time to speak with the coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- I will address any issues or concerns with the team coach or an ASB board member
