Addison is committed to providing continued communication to our parents and staff during this time of unprecedented school closings. Here is the latest information to share at this time:

- All Addison Community School buildings will continue to be closed until further notice. This includes all indoor and outdoor facilities.
- Our custodial staff are currently off and will return on April 6th. At that point they will be busy performing a deep cleaning of all spaces in our district to ensure they are safe for students and staff when we are expected to return on Tuesday, April 14.
- We are providing meals on Monday's and Wednesday to be picked up in the bus loop between the hours of 11:00-1:00. Each pick up day will have a breakfast and lunch for that day and the following day(s).
- Spring Break is still scheduled for the week of April 6 – 10, 2020, unless directed otherwise by the Governor or the Michigan Department of Education (MDE).
- All athletic teams cannot practice until our return on Tuesday, April 14th.
- Although the MDE does not allow us to count remote learning during this period, we encourage parents to continue have their child read and explore educational opportunities via on-line.
- To keep your family safe and healthy, we encourage parents and staff to follow the CDC recommends the following everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases, including COVID-19:
 - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
 - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
 - Stay home when you are sick.
 - Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
 - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
