On October 16, 2020, we were notified that a contracted employee within our district tested positive for COVID-19. The school worked with Lenawee County Health Department to determine whether there were close contacts. The good news is that there were no students or staff that were in close contact with this individual. The individual's identity will remain confidential. The definition of close contact is listed below.

CLOSE CONTACT

What is considered a close contact? A close contact is anyone who has been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19, which includes:

- Being within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes (cumulative)
- Providing care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
- Having direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
- Sharing eating or drinking utensils
- They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you
