Today, we were notified that a student from the high school tested positive for COVID-19. The school worked with Lenawee County Health Department to determine who were the close contacts. We have notified the close contacts and informed them of being quarantined for 14 days. The individual's identity will remain confidential. The definition of close contact is listed below.

CLOSE CONTACT

What is considered a close contact? A close contact is anyone who has been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19, which includes:

- Being within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes (cumulative)
- Providing care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
- Having direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
- Sharing eating or drinking utensils
- They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you
