Dear Parent/Guardian,

We have been notified of a Positive COVID-19 staff member within **Addison Community Schools**. We have worked with the Lenawee County Health Department (LCHD) to ensure that close contacts are identified and appropriate actions are taken.

- **Students in Mrs. Lucey and Ms. Hall class have been identified as close contacts.**
- **These students needs to be in home quarantine for a total of 14 days past the last time they were exposed to the person with COVID-19.**
- If your child has remained symptom free throughout the entire quarantine period, he/she may return to school and normal activities on **Date: Monday, February 1, 2021**

## **QUARANTINE**

**Quarantine is an important step in preventing the spread of COVID-19.** People placed in quarantine must stay home, separate themselves from others if possible, and monitor for any symptoms of COVID-19. When feasible, they should use a designated area of the home, including restroom facilities, that no one else should enter or use. If your child develops any symptoms consistent with COVID-19, please call your child's healthcare provider as well as the school. Symptoms of COVID-19 may include: fever/chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, new loss of taste/smell, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, nausea/vomiting, or diarrhea.

## **TESTING**

**Anyone with symptoms should be tested.** Even if your child does not have symptoms, though, you can still have them tested. **Please note, if your child tests negative, he/she will still have to complete the rest of the quarantine period and continue to monitor for symptoms.**
